***Crime Report:*** Tony Prosser reported to the NPNA Board a slight decrease in crime incidents. There were 25 incidents in the 28-day period ending February 10<sup>th</sup>.

***Wednesday Summer Bite Nights in the Park:*** Cheryl Gerwin spoke with Paige Romero, an independent Food Truck and Event Coordinator. Paige currently coordinates all food truck rotations, entertainment, permits and trash pickup for Altura & Hyder Parks' food truck events. Discussions are in process and the Board hopes to work with Paige on coordinating our events as City of Albuquerque COVID rules allow.

***Carlisle Crossing:*** The old Kmart site will be called Carlisle Crossing and will feature a 50,000 square foot Whole Foods Market, the existing Burger King and two building pads

for future retail stores. The NPNA Board is keeping an eye on this project and will report to the membership as more details become available.

**Indian School Road Update:** Bike path construction which will direct cyclists under Indian School continues with anticipated completion in March, 2021. Speed Monitoring Signs are currently up on Indian School between Carlisle and Girard. One sign appears to be working intermittently.

**Urban Forest Guardians:** Bill Gannon reported graffiti and it has been cleaned. Because it is a sort of "wild" park, the Urban Forest is not regularly maintained by the City like other parks. However a NEW SIGN to the park was just installed at Indian School; other improvements like better trash maintenance, fencing in the works. We thank Dave Simon and the City Parks crews for their hard work on this.

**Bike Trail Cleanup:** The annual NPNA Bike Trail trash pickup is Saturday 6 March at 9 AM; it only takes a couple of hours. You can help by meeting at Applebee's on Menaul. We will work south on the North Diversion Channel to Indian School can shuttle back or walk home. Rolling garbage cans and bags supplied; bring/wear gloves, masks, etc. Make Albuquerque a nicer place. Good karma is not free, it is best earned.
