Netherwood Yesterdays

The history of our neighborhood has always been enriched by the faculty, staff, and students of the University of New Mexico. Alcinda Morrow and Martha Taylor were there to greet students when the University first opened in the fall of 1892. Ms. Morrow was born in Indiana in 1843 and taught at the University of Kansas from 1877 to 1880, followed by teaching assignments in Minnesota and Argentina. She was professor of Education and Spanish at UNM and she was the founder of the English Department. She joined with her friends, Ada Cutler and Martha Taylor, to purchase land in what is now our neighborhood on May 21, 1896. She resigns from UNM, gets married that July, and moves with her husband to Los Angeles. She sells her land to Ada Cutler in 1905 and dies five years later.
