Benches in Netherwood Park:

Chuck talked to City Parks and Recreation about having a bench put in Netherwood Park at the highest point on the SW corner by Schell and Morrow. Since the budget is tight for the City, it would cost the NPNA \$800-\$900, but the City would install it and take care of it. There is a wait list for used benches but these may not be in good condition. The Board wants to hear comments from neighbors about benches in the Park.

Soon the 85 and older population in Albuquerque will increase by 230 per cent and Albuquerque needs to be prepared.
