Neighbors continue to find used needles in our two parks. Here is important safety information from the City's website <http://www.cabq.gov/environmentalhealth/sharps-disposal>

NEVER handle needles with bare hands - assume they are contaminated.

NEVER attempt to snap, remove or bend needles, or put the cap back on.

NEVER place sharps in a glass or light plastic container or a milk carton that could break or allow needles to poke through.

NEVER allow children to handle needles.

Project Updates

The NPNA Board did not receive new information on the following important projects:

The Old Kmart Building: The City Environmental Planning Commission did approve a zoning change to NMX-M (Upzone Mixed Use) No other details are available now. No new meetings are scheduled at this time.

Indian School Traffic Calming: There is an agreement in place for a 35MPH speed limit for the entire length of the NPNA area. The City Traffic Engineering Department would like to see an estimated timeline on replacing signage. Other items such as increasing bike lane size and traffic light at Stanford are now still in research phases.

Netherwood Park Bench Ribbon Cutting: This event is set for June 26th at 7:30 City Councilor Isaac Benton will be able to attend but not until 7:40pm due to other engagements. The NPNA Board will provide refreshments.

Indian School Bike Path Underpass: construction to begin early summer 2020.
