Food Trucks are back at Netherwood Park

The NPNA Board met on June 9th at the Tennis Club of Albuquerque.

Tony Prosser presented the **crime report** for the period from May 12 to June 8, 2021. There were only fourteen incidents in this twenty-eight-day timeframe. The net result is sixty percent less from the prior month. Our neighborhood remains fairly calm in crimes in relation to surrounding areas. The board discussed the new New Mexico liquor law that goes into effect on July 1, 2021 and its possible impact on our neighborhood. This law eliminates the sale of mini-liquor bottles as well as the 300-foot distance required for liquor sales near schools and churches.

The Netherwood Park Bites program on Wednesday nights continues to exceed expectations. The ending of covid-19 restrictions in July could mean that music and face painting programs will be added.

You will see some activity at the **old Kmart/Carlisle Crossings** site. Angela Williamson, the Modulus architect, told Bill Gannon her firm has received city permit for demolition that will start around June 18th. Construction will take around eight months for the full ten acres of new parking, landscaping, lighting, walkways, sidewalks, etc. There will be a 44,890 square foot Whole Foods as well as 65,000 square feet for remaining tenants. The full tenant list should be finalized in a few weeks. Modulus is also waiting on final approval from the City Development Review Board for off-site work on improvements to Carlisle and Indian School city right of way.



NPNA Board Member Spencer Gerwin reported that at least five people committed to get **the tree planting program** underway in the fall with the help of Tree New Mexico. Some of their staff has already met with the NPNA Board. Contact Spencer for more details.
