



After the Governor's veto of money for a playground in Netherwood Park, the City requested a higher response rate of residents. To foster communication between neighbors and the City, the Board President is calling a balloted special meeting. While the vote will be an official position of the membership, understand that any decision is entirely at the discretion of the City and our elected officials. All adults 18 and up who live (including renters), own property, or a business, within the boundaries are eligible to vote as a member. No dues required. You may return your ballot in advance via the internet, or mail, or in person on or before the meeting **Wednesday, July 17** at 4-6PM.
